## What Your Child Learned Today

Jesus's glory was displayed through his first miracle, and many people believed in him as a result. His miracles are a gift to us, too. In reading them, we can also believe in Jesus as the Son of God.

## Try This

Sit with your child and enjoy a glass of juice. Open a children's Bible and talk together about some of the miracles of Jesus. Begin with the wedding at Cana and discuss how Jesus turned water into wine. Continue with Jesus healing the sick and raising the dead. Discuss how reading these amazing accounts in the Scriptures has encouraged your faith in Jesus.

## Jesus's First Sign at Cana

- Scripture: John 2:1–11
- Big Idea: Jesus showed us that he is the Son of God. We can believe in him!
- Memory Verse: "His mother said to the servants, 'Do what he tells you.'" John 2:5

## SOMETHING ELSE TO DO

Write today's memory verse on an index card and tape it on or near the supper table. Each night this week, recite the verse together. Each day, write the verse on another card, leaving out one or two words. See who can remember the missing word(s). On the final evening, see if anyone can recite the entire verse. The first person to remember the verse gets the first serving of dessert!

## Table Talk

- ▶ **As a family, make a list of Jesus's miracles (without looking in a Bible). Then, look in a Bible or search the Internet for a list of the miracles of Jesus. How many did you come up with on your own? Were you surprised by any that you missed? Which miracle does your child find the most amazing and why? Does this miracle help your child see that Jesus is the Son of God? Does it help them trust Jesus with their life and faith?**
