## What Your Child Learned Today

Today your child heard about the first miracle of Jesus recorded in the Bible. Your child learned how this miracle gave the disciples confidence in Jesus, helping them to follow him and learn from him. We learn from this Scripture passage that we, too, can have confidence in Jesus as the Messiah, trusting in him and following his teachings.

## Try This

Bring out your family's favorite children's Bible. Look through the table of contents and read aloud all the stories that record Jesus's miracles. Count the titles to see how many there are. Explain to your child that these are the miracles that are recorded, but John tells us that there were many miracles of Jesus that did not get recorded (see John 21:25). Ask your child to pick one of the miracle stories for you to read together. Discuss how the story displays Jesus's divinity. Discuss how this story can give your family confidence in Jesus as the Son of God.

## Jesus's First Sign at Cana

- Scripture: John 2:1–11
- Big Idea: Jesus showed us that he is the Son of God. We can believe in him!
- Memory Verse: "His mother said to the servants, 'Do what he tells you.'" John 2:5

## SOMETHING ELSE TO DO

The next time your family finishes a meal, ask your child to help you wash a few dishes. As they are filling the glasses or bowls with water, remind them about the time the servants filled the jars for Jesus. Retell the story as the two of you are cleaning or loading the dishwasher. Remind your child that we can trust Jesus because he is the Son of God.

## Table Talk

- ▶ **Prepare a dinner for a guest who has a story to share about a miracle in their life. Invite a friend or a church member who has a story about a time when they received help from God. Continue the discussion after your guest leaves. Discuss how hearing from someone firsthand gives us a different perspective on God's great miracles and gives us confidence in the greatness of God.**
