How long will this take?

This will vary greatly from person to person, but allow 30 to 45 minutes per module. The two largest variables are your computer's download speed and your work style. Tips to keep the time in that frame: choose a computer with a strong internet connection (wired is typically faster than wireless) and set yourself up to minimize interruptions (turn off electronics, close the door to the room, etc.).

Do I need to complete the modules in order?

The modules are listed in the most logical order for most people to learn. However, you may complete the first five modules in any order that makes sense to you. The last module is the agreement which needs to be completed after you view and understand the first five modules.

My ministry is with senior adults. Do I need to complete the modules geared at protecting children?

Yes. While one's ministry may be primarily with one age group, it is each parishioner's responsibility to protect all members of our church. Remember that most of the principles related to children relate to other age groups as well. The statistics may be somewhat different, but the principles remain true.

Can I stop in the middle of a module, save it and complete it later?

No. However, the video will not time out, so if you take a short break you should be able to continue when you come back to it.

How long do I have to complete all six modules?

Please complete all six modules within two weeks.
