The best kept secret at Christ Church is our Rite 1 Eucharist on Wednesday mornings followed conversation and light refreshments in the coffee area outside the chapel.



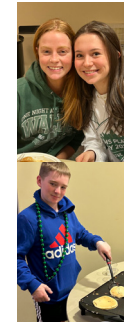
### Help us flower the cross on Easter!
