

Before the introduction of the 1979 Book of Common Prayer (our current prayer book), the Holy Eucharist was not the principal service each Sunday in most Episcopal parishes. Morning Prayer was the norm for most Sundays, with Holy Communion being celebrated once or twice each month. Project Host still needs our help providing hot and cold meals to the special emphasis neighborhoods of Greenville.


