Inviting to All – Kay Jenkins

Kay began with a story about a parishioner named George. He looked unkempt and homeless, but always looked out for Christ Church. One day during an EYC event, George was outside serving as a greeter although no one knew who had asked him to do that. When Kay asked him if he would like to come in for something to eat, he said, "No, thank you. There were lots of youth going in and out who could get picked up by someone wanting to cause trouble." Kay realized that he didn't want to leave from the outside because he was looking out for those who were inside. She had thought of George as the one needing help, but instead he was offering his gift of watching over others.

- Q: What happened to George?
- A: He passed away in his 60s. His family has deep roots at Christ Church.
- Q: Inreach/Outreach same thing or different thing?
- A: Inreach is for parishioners. Outreach is for the community.
- A: Should be complementary
- A: Someone doesn't need to be on the inside to need our help. Don't dismiss anybody.

Comments:

- George was an angel and angels are God's messengers.
- George knew who you were and had the gift to know people and relate in a personal way.
- There is no difference between George and us. We just mask it differently.

Inviting to All – Reid Sherard

Inviting is more than welcoming. We don't realize that others may see us differently than we see ourselves. We've invited people to visit, but have we really stepped out of our comfort zone?

Christ Church is blessed with worldly gifts, but we need to be vigilant in how we work with others. Not just talk about being inviting to all, but we need to do more. No one should be dismissed.

Christ Church Preschool finished with a loss due to increasing salaries to retain staff. They are using their grant money from DHEC to maintain.
